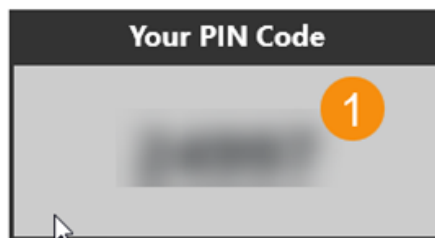
When you submit your email address, you will receive an email from us with a link that will prompt you to enter the PIN Code provided (1).
